



Term appointment for Adjunct Professor and Sessional Lecturer

UBC School of Information invites applications for a term appointment to teach the following in-person course:

- ARST 500 Information Technology and Archives
- Winter 2021 Term 2 Jan – April 2022

Adjunct Professors and Sessional Lecturers are expected to prepare and teach a 3-credit course during the term. This course comprises of usually thirteen classes of three hours each. The current salary for a 3-credit course is approximately \$8,000.

The School of Information will consider applicants with a PhD or Master's degree in Library, Archival and Information studies, and with relevant professional experience.
